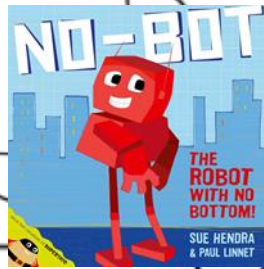


Ladybirds newsletter No. 5 12.10.2023
