Our topic is 'Colours'

This week: We have learnt the story of 'The rainbow fish' and how it is good to be kind, and that sharing is caring. We have tried writing some simple words from the story. We have got to grips with 'more', 'fewer' and 'equal' in maths. We have been busy practising our Nativity and we have discussed Christmas and Advent with the start of December. The children have also been completing the half termly Little Wandle phonic assessments, naming phase 2 sounds, and trying to read phase 2, and tricky words.

Next week: We will have a four day week and will be learning the story of the Nativity, as part of our R.E. learning, using the book 'The Christmas promise'. We will be learning about 4 sided shapes for maths and will be busy with Christmas crafts and play, plus completion of phonic assessments.
