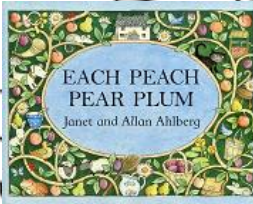


Ladybirds Home learning newsletter No. 20
