# Please teach your child how to put on their coat independently.

Now the Autumnal weather has arrived please send your child into nursery with a named coat/waterproof jacket every day that will protect them from the elements.

Show an increasing desire to be independent, such as wanting to feed themselves and dress or undress. (Age 0-3 Development Matters)

Be increasingly independent as they get dressed and undressed, for example, putting coats on and doing up zips. (Age 3-4 Development Matters.
