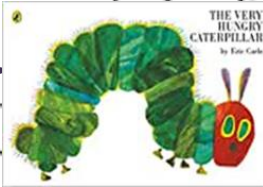


Ladybirds Home learning newsletter No. 28 25th April 2024

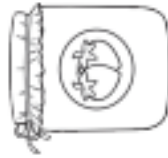
