Home Learning:

Weekly home learning will be given for English and Maths as well as daily revision leading up to SATs. Home learning will usually be a consolidation of work that we have covered in class. In addition to set home learning, your child should read for at least **20 minutes a day**.

School Uniform:

Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct school uniform at all times and on **Wednesdays**, when Year 6 have PE, your child comes to school wearing their full PE kit, which includes clothes for warmth as we will be holding sessions outside where possible. Forest Schools kit lists for sessions this year can also be obtained from Mrs Pope, Forest Schools leader, when required. Further information on swimming sessions will follow.

As the weather is becoming warmer, please encourage your child to bring a bottle of water into class to ensure they can have a drink during lesson time.
