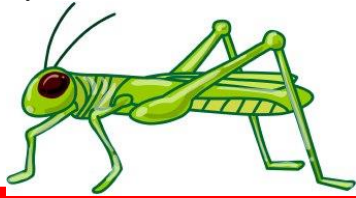


Grasshoppers Class Important information

Home Learning:
