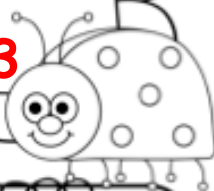




Ladybirds Home learning newsletter

Welcome to the weekly Ladybirds home learning newsletter.

The children are settling in well and are learning the rules and routines of school. Tapestry will be up and running within the next week. The children are making new friends and playing nicely together. Our topic is **Amazing Me!** The children will be creating a display of self portraits.

REWARDS

We reward all our Ladybirds when they follow the school rules. Rewards include stickers for their individual sticker charts, raffle tickets, certificates and whole class gems in the jar. When children complete their sticker chart they choose a gift from the 'grab box'. Small donations of quality small toys or bubbles are always welcome for this.

NUMBERS

Each week we will have a number/maths focus. We will follow the 'White Rose' scheme to ensure children have a good foundation knowledge of numbers. Your child will have their own number poster in their book bag for weekly home practice. They may like to practise studying the numbers, saying the number names, counting the amounts and practising writing the numerals.

PHONICS

Each week we will be learning sounds/letters using the 'Little Wandle' scheme for phonics.

All children take part in national phonics screening (at the end of Year 1) and need to have completed all 5 phases of phonics in order to pass. Therefore, we would be very grateful if you could regularly practise graphemes (letter names) and phonemes (sounds) at home. In their bag will be a 'Caterpillar' sounds book. Practise the sounds and tricky words in this, with your child at home, and when they can recognise them in any order, we will glue in a new set of sounds in. We test the children each week on these.

Extra parent support guidance will be sent using 'Little Wandle' materials, plus a reading and phonics workshop **Thurs 21st Sept 2:45pm** Alphablocks TV programmes are a great place to start. Plus, 'Steve says - Cued articulation' videos on YouTube.

READING

Once a week, your child will be given a reading book to bring home - please read with your child at least 4 times a week and sign their reading record by writing the name of the book and a short comment. Children start with picture books with no words to help their imaginative story telling. Children will also be bringing home 'caterpillar words and sounds' to learn. Guidance for both these activities will be stuck inside these books, and discussed at the 'Reading and phonics' session' (date **Thurs 21st Sept 2:45pm**). At school the children will take part in daily guided reading activities including individual reading, group reading, learning a weekly text linked to our topic
