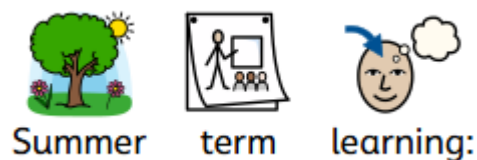


**Kites Class
