### ABSENCE & HOLIDAY REQUESTS

I have noticed an increase in the number of requests for term time holidays since September. I would like to remind you that the Head Teacher, on behalf of the Governing Body, can grant leave, at their discretion, for up to <u>5 days in any school year in EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES</u>. (Please note - A 'Family Holiday' does not meet the criteria for 'exceptional circumstances'). This includes leaving school early.

In accordance with guidance from Surrey County Council no holidays will be authorised at the beginning of the academic year, or during May due to end of year assessments. No parents/carers can demand leave of absence for their children as a right. Holidays taken without the permission of the Governing Body may result in legal action being taken against each parent.

Whilst the school will grant requests for absence for dental and medical treatments, parents/carers are encouraged, whenever possible, to book dental and medical appointments outside of the school day. When appointments during the school day are unavoidable, the school office should be notified in advance in writing, of the date and time of the appointment and when the child will be collected and/or returned to school. Evidence of the appointment should be provided.

#### **LATENESS**

It is expected that children will arrive at school on time. Did you know that being 15 minutes late each day is the same as missing two weeks of school over the year. Lateness is just as serious as non-attendance and could also lead to a Fixed Penalty Notice. The start of the school day is an important time for children to develop their social skills with their peers, as well as preparing them for their learning. We start teaching at 8.50am and 'late' children miss out on vital skills such as phonics and/or basic number work. In cases of persistent late arrival to school, school will liaise with the parents/carers to identify reasons for the persistent lateness and provide appropriate support and guidance. The matter may be referred to the Inclusion Officer for investigation.

Children are required by law to attend school 190 days per year. The Government states that every pupil's attendance should be at least 95%. Being **LATE** after registration will also **LOWER** your attendance.
