Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you all had an enjoyable half term either at home or away. We have a very busy term ahead of us with many festive activities already in the diary.

I would like to say a huge thank you to all parents and our amazing FOSS team (Friends of Stepgates Community School) for organising another very successful 'Break the Rules at Stepgates' yesterday. The children had a wonderful day breaking rules!

Kites Class have had a very busy couple of weeks in school. On Tuesday 1st, Thursday 3rd and Tuesday 8th the children welcomed our visitors and conducted tours of the school for our Open Mornings and Open Evening, which have been very well attended. We received some wonderful comments from our visitors and once again the parents commented on how well behaved, friendly and polite all the children were.

On Wednesday 9th November, our Year 6 children were able to take part in Junior Citizenship activities at Thorpe Park. 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
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FOSS HALLOWEEN DISCOupdate
