Kites Evacuee Day

Kites took at trip back in time on Friday 18th November, to 1st September, 1939. We arrived in school dressed as evacuees and took our seats at what looked like quite a different classroom. Mrs Brough was very different too – she was very strict!

After assembly, we prepared out name labels and gas masks and made our way to Waterloo Train Station (the playground). Here, we boarded the train and made a long and exhausting journey to a village in the Countryside. Once we had arrived, we were met by the Billeting Officer, who directed us to the village hall (the school hall). All of the adults in Year 6 were in role and came along to select the children they would take into their homes as part of the evacuation. Some of us stayed on a farm, where we were looked after by one of the Land girls, others went to stay at the Manor house and the rest of the Children were looked after by the baker's wife. After this, we got to know our 'host families' and did some chores!

Throughout the day we got to experience what it would have been like for the evacuees. We wrote postcards home to our parents, sung Wartime songs and played card games. Later in the day, we got to see what food was rationed and how little this was (with real food!) We were also very lucky to have a visit from Daniel's mum, who very kindly came in to show us her Grandad's war medals from when he was a Desert Rat!

We had a great day!
