#### MESSAGE FROM MRS FORD, HEADTEACHER

#### Dear Parents/Carers

Happy New Year to you all and welcome back to a new term at Stepgates. I hope everyone enjoyed a happy and healthy Christmas. Thank you very much for all the good wishes, cards and presents given to myself and staff. The children have settled back into school quickly and we are all looking forward to an exciting term at Stepgates. You should all be receiving Curriculum Information for this half term and further information is available on the website for each class. This explains the children's learning for this term, regular events e.g. PE, homework expectations etc. and how you can support them at home.

#### CLUBS

As a small school we are very lucky to be able to offer such a varied range of after school clubs and activities for the children. I would like to thank the teaching staff, the LSA's and the parents who give freely of their time to help ensure the continued success of our clubs programme. You might not be aware that staff and parents offer these clubs on a **voluntary basis** only and I am very grateful to them for their continued support, commitment and enthusiasm without which our selection of clubs would be much reduced. If there are any parents who would like to assist with a club, please contact the school office.

#### ATTENDANCE

As you are aware this year we are aiming for whole school attendance above 95.0%. Unfortunately attendance for Autumn Term was 91.4%, well below our target. I understand childhood infections had an impact on attendance in Autumn Term but I know we can do better! Our Inclusion Officer continues to visit school to monitor children's attendance. Please ensure your child is in school every day unless they are really unwell and likely to be infectious.

Well done to the 36 children who achieved 100% attendance for the Autumn term.

You will be receiving a Red, Amber or Green Attendance letter for your child based on their attendance last term. Individual attendance for a child should be at least 95%; anything above this generates a 'Green' letter. Attendance below 90% generates a 'Red' letter as this is well below what is expected, and attendance between 90% and 95% generates an 'Amber' letter. These figures do not relate to whether the absences are authorised or not, they are based on overall attendance for the term.
