If you're like us and recently had a sort out but have nowhere to take your unwanted clothes and items, look no further than here! Bag2School is an organisation that helps raise funds for schools and other charities by collecting unwanted clothes.

### Bag2School will accept the following 'good quality' items for reuse:

- · Men's, Ladies' and Children's clothing
- Paired shoes (tied together or elastic band around)
- Handbags
- Hats
- Bags
- · Scarves and ties
- Jewellery
- · Lingerie
- Socks
- Belts
- Soft toys
- Household linenHousehold curtains
- Household towels
- Household bedding (bed sheets, pillow cases and duvet covers)

### Items that won't be accepted by Bag2School:

- · Duvets and blankets
- Pillows and cushions
- Carpets, rugs and mats (including bath, shower and toilet mats)
- · Soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing
- · School uniforms with and without logo
- Corporate clothing and workwear
- · Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material

Please, please do not hand in wet, stained or school-branded clothing. Each bag will be checked, so please make sure these guidelines are followed.

Drop off at the gates to the school car park on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September between 8-9am and 3-4pm. Or earlier/later by arrangement with FOSS.
